Semester Abroad Programs in Strasbourg, France

Academics **Plus+**

Signature events and activities included in the program:

- International Culture and Career Seminar
- Community engagement and volunteer opportunities at local organizations
- Yoga classes are offered once a week at the Château de Pourtalès. Students can join the classes free of charge.

Accommodation **Plus+**

Students enrolled in the Exchange Plus program receive excellent housing and services included in the fee:

- CEPA Foundation arranges housing at the Château de Pourtalès (double occupancy, shared bathrooms). **Students at the Château de Pourtalès will have the following included in their fee:** computer lab, wi-fi internet access, well-equipped student kitchen, student lounge, weekly yoga classes, laundry, library, refrigerators in student rooms, recreational facilities are located on the premises and nearby.

Day & Weekend Trips **Plus+**

Multiple excursions and trips in Belgium, France, and Germany are included in the program, such as:

- 3 day/2 night trip to Brussels, Belgium including transportation, hostel, and visits to 3-4 international institutions
- Visit the EU Parliament, Council of Europe, European Court of Human Rights, and EURO Institute
- Visit the German Central Bank, German Stock Exchange, and the German Federal Constitutional Court (Bundesverfassungsgericht) in Karlsruhe
- Guided tour of the Haut Koenigsbourg Castle
- Visit the former concentration camp Struthof
- Day trip to the city of Heidelberg, Germany with a guided walking tour and visit to the famous Heidelberg Castle
- Guided walking tour of Strasbourg
- Guided tour of the Historical Museum in Strasbourg
- Professional visit to an multinational company in the region

Activities listed above are based on availability and will vary each semester.

Personal Support **Plus+**

- Comprehensive orientation session
- Personal support before, during, and after the program from our multi-lingual team in Strasbourg
- Students receive 6 hours of basic French lessons

Cultural and Social **Plus+**

- Activities bringing French and North American students together held regularly at the Château de Pourtalès
- Special seasonal parties held at the Château de Pourtalès, such as Halloween, Thanksgiving, Easter

Meals **Plus+**

- Welcome reception at the Château de Pourtalès
- Group dinner at the start of the semester
- Delicious French breakfast buffet served every morning at the Château de Pourtalès
- Tarte flambeé group dinner
- Group dinner at a restaurant in Brussels
- Special holiday group meal, depending on the season
- Farewell group dinner at the end of the semester

Safety and Logistics **Plus+**

- On-site team available for health and safety assistance
- One group pick-up and transfer for students who arrive at Frankfurt International Airport at the designated day/time
- Public transportation pass for Strasbourg for the duration of the program
- All ground transfers for the activities and excursions included in the program by private, coach bus

Fee: \$7,950 per student

Includes all of the services as described for a 16 week semester program.

The Spring semester is generally 4-5 weeks longer than the Fall semester. A \$750 supplement will apply.

Eligibility

Institutions from the University of Strasbourg exchange partner network are invited to enroll their students in the program.
